Until mid-July	On Ave. Lakeview, between Ave. Hampton Gardens and Chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore Local traffic only
Until the end of September	 On Ave. Lakeview, between Blvd. Saint-Jean and Ave. Hampton Gardens Local traffic only
Mid-July to mid-October	 On Chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore, between Ave. Lakeview and Ave. Ovide The intersection with Ave. Lakeview will be completely closed Terrasse Armand residents can reach the detour via Chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore to the east Parc Ovide facilities will remain accessible via Chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore from the east only.
Mid-October to December and May to June 2025	 On Chemin Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore road, between Ave. Ovide and Ave. Lakeside Parc Ovide facilities will remain accessible from Chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore from the west only

Where is the site crew?



Managing site staff is an integral part of project planning. During stages that require a break (paint drying, concrete curing, asphalt cooling, etc.), or that are not carried out in the field (repairing a part, testing drinking water, etc.), staff are temporarily assigned to another project.
